We would like to introduce you to some of Tajima's most beautiful scenery; waterfalls, flowers, and geological heritage.





This waterfall (98 meters high) has been selected as not only the BEST in Hyogo, it has also been selected amongst the top 100 waterfalls in Japan. It is 1.2 km from the valley entrance to the waterfall. You will pass seven smaller falls upon your arrival to the great Tentaki Waterfall. The hike there is beautiful

If you are lucky, you may encounter the breathtaking view of the Takeda Castle Ruins when it is surrounded by a famous sea of white fluffy clouds. This can be seen most often during the winter and fall seasons. The nice early morning weather allows for the mist of clouds to fall around the ruins. It is a real treat if you get the chance to experience the view from Ritsu-un-Kyō on the other side.
